The Canadian Council on Social Development has been doing work on poverty and social justice for nearly 90 years. We are hosting the Canadian Social Forum at Calgary's Telus Centre, May 19-22, 2009. Decision makers, activists, frontline workers, folks in health, community justice workers and many others from across the country will be there. That's more than 750 people – together in one place for three days – all brainstorming to create sustainable solutions to poverty.

Video will be an important tool to capture the ideas and energy at this event. And we are looking for a team of smart, creative videographers, producers and editors to help us tell that story.

Over the four days, you'll have the opportunity to meet and interview people who are making a difference in communities across the country.

Work is divided into four-hour shifts and we are asking for a commitment of at least two shifts from each applicant. An honorarium will be paid for each shift. And the video team is also being invited to participate in a special workshop conducted by CBC National Television journalist, Mark Kelley.
